NAME OF DEPARTMENT: Gateway Youth Club

WHAT WE DID LAST YEAR: Gateway Youth Club has been more or less business as usual. As mentioned in Impact report, we had a maths tutor for many months, so the first hour tutoring the second hour games, (6:00 to 8:00pm every week)

Apart from financing Wales's trip in the first half of 2018, we had more money from Jack Petchey. We have used the money to refurbish our Games, new Headsets for PS4, new Basket Balls and football. We've also been able to buy a keyboard worth £100 pounds for the youth to hone their musical skills.

Having being given the opportunity to lead worship in the coming months of Family service, they have started talking about setting up a youth choir. That means, they don't need to move or touch the big church key board each time they practice, they have a dedicated youth instruments.

WHAT WE INTEND TO DO THIS YEAR:

As mentioned before, the main users of Gateway are still the Youth of our church, except for one. Hence what I said on the Impact report applies here too.

I plan to go back to the primary schools we have worked before, and visit the local secondary schools too. If they allow us, we give the year six children a Scripture Union booklet about moving to secondary school, "Your Move"
And hopefully contribute in the assemblies and Christian union of the secondary schools.

Where possible, we have also discussed, with some trustees, forging links with Jubilee church youth for football, or other youth events.
